Hard to believe we only have three more days until our 2nd2None 5K Run & Walk! It looks like we are going to have an awesome morning, with no rain forecasted, sunshine galore and temperatures predicted to be near 70!! We hope you, as a runner or walker, are as excited about it as we are.

Just a reminder that **pre-registration closes tomorrow, April 26th**. After that the adult race day registration will be \$35.00 and youth 18 and under is \$15.00. You can register as a walk-in on the day of the race at Wilder Park from 6:00 a.m.-7:30 a.m.

For those who have pre-registered, your goody bag, bib number and shirt will be available in the pre-registration area. If you are part of a team, we will have a pre-registration pick-up area exclusively for you, so please have a team captain come and get the goody bags, etc. from us. This will keep the lines shorter if only one person from the team is in line. Walk-in registrants will sign-in at the race day registration table. All of these will be located under our large tent. Just follow the signs.

Parking is free at River Street, north of New York Street. Keep your eyes open for the large tent, the growing crowd, and the Parking Signs.
